EXIT GHOST? 25 YEARS AFTER THE FALL OF THE BERLIN WALL

A Critical Commemoration of German Unification

November 6-7 - NYC

One generation after the end of the Cold War and German unification, the fall of the Berlin Wall on November 9th, 1989, remains an epoch-changing moment. How have the intervening years impacted the lives of former East and West Germans and today's German political landscape? RLS-NYC is co-hosting two events together with the New School for Public Engagement to discuss the politics of history, identity, and collective memory, consisting of the U.S. premiere of the play "1989 [Exit Ghost]", performed by the Dresden-based troupe *theatrale subversion*, and a public conference with the performers as well as panelists from the media, arts, politics, and academia.
