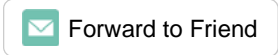

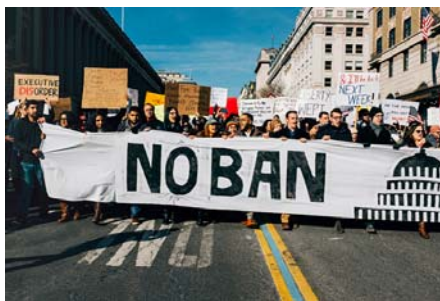
FEBRUARY 19: FILM SCREENING: A TALE FROM BARCELONA
